


It is a management and arbitration tool, a platform dedicated to the fostering of strategic thinking and exchanges of information and ideas between French Agriculture and Fishery sectors.



Ours missions

The French agriculture and fishery sectors are facing many challenges: feeding the planet, preserving the environment, increasing economic performances, in particular exports. As a service provider, FranceAgriMer:

- > monitors markets and provides an **economic expertise**, helping operators in the agriculture and sea sectors to design development strategies;
- > ensures cooperation and close **dialogue** between the eleven specialized Committees for the different sectors and monitors the implementation of government policies within these Committees;
- > Monitors the organization of producers and their cooperation with the administrative regions;
- monitors market regulation instruments and manages national and EU subsidies;
- > Takes part in **technical cooperation** activities and helps promoting French sectors abroad.







FranceAgriMer in figures


To fulfill its mandate FranceAgriMer employs 1, 270 people to carry out its tasks,

among which 410 working in the different administrative regions.

In 2013, 840 million Euros were allocated to the agriculture and fishery sectors, among which 70% funded by EU subsidies and 30% by national subsidies.

6 million Euros were also allocated to data acquisition and economic studies.


FranceAgriMer also controls the management of a variety of financial instruments, including about 2 billion euros in "supports" for the cereal producers.

FranceAgriMer also includes three national offices: one office in Libourne, which monitors some of the measures for the vine growing market; one in La Rochelle, where cereal analyses are conducted in a specialized laboratory; one in Volx, which monitors aromatic and medicinal plants, as well as Mediterranean products (olive oil and rice).



FranceAgriMer also has territorial services within every Regional Office for food, agriculture and forest (DRAAF). Regional agents work closely with producers and operators for every sector. They monitor inspection audits, data processing and answer to operator's requests.
